Dear STREAM Youth Theology Institute Applicant,

Attached you will find application materials for the 2016 STREAM Youth Theological Institute to be held on the campus of Virginia Union University in Richmond, Virginia, July 1-9, 2016. This is the inaugural summer for this program, funded in part through a grant from the Lilly Endowment. We are delighted by your interest!

At STREAM Youth Theology Institute, we believe that there is a wonderful connection between what your interests are, who God created you to be, and your ability to transform the world around you. Just suppose your love for science, technology, math, history, or the arts are God-given gifts to be offered to promote social justice and the common good, in the future and now. As such, we gather approximately fifty rising high school juniors and seniors from this region and across the country for a life-changing nine-day experience exploring vocation, community, culture, and lifelong faith formation. Our goal is to help you explore your faith and discern where your gifts and passions meet the world's deepest needs in a supportive mentoring community where your views, talents, and insights are respected and encouraged.

So what does this look like? It's honest, complicated, and energizing as we live out our commitment to wrestling with what it means to be a person of faith in the midst of everyday life. We'll make it possible for you to engage in academic exploration, vocational discernment, cultural engagement, and community-building with a diverse group of other students your age, as well as Virginia Union faculty, current graduate and undergraduate students, and national and regional community leaders. You might find yourself exploring "Policy, Politics, and Prophesy" and engaging ideas about speaking truth to power. You might engage in dialogue with a Black Lives Matter leader around questions about the "Righteousness of Rebellion." You will have an opportunity to understand more about how money works through exploration of "Money, Materialism, and Social Entrepreneurism," and we will engage questions around "History and Hope" while celebrating Independence Day in historic Richmond (with a cookout and fireworks). Because we are a community rich in diversity, you'll learn about other people, and learn how to engage honestly and respectfully with people whose experiences, commitments, and perspectives are different from yours. You'll have opportunities to gather in celebration and worship and to share your unique gifts. And there will be time for relaxation and play, with activities like dance, basketball, arts and music, laser tag, and maybe even a little dodgeball.

Because the program schedule is so full, and because we emphasize the importance of building a community as part of our work together, we require that all STREAM participants must be present for the entire program, arriving on July 1 by 4 p.m. and departing on July 9 around 4 p.m. It's not possible for you to participate in other programs (e.g., music or sports camp, family reunions or parties, etc.) during the nine days of the STREAM Youth Theology Institute.

We know that this kind of opportunity is a choice for you, and that it limits other options for summer study or employment. We believe so strongly in STREAM that we make the program available to you at a fee far lower than it costs to host the program — participants pay only the subsidized rate of \$500. <u>Please do not let the cost</u> of STREAM keep you from applying. We will work with you, your family, home congregation, church association, or hometown to make it possible for you to attend.

Enclosed are the following application materials for the STREAM Youth Theology Institute:

- an Application Form for you to complete, which includes four essay questions, and
- two **Recommendation Forms** to be completed by adults who know you well, but are not related to you;

We'd prefer to receive all of your application materials in one package. Your recommenders should return the forms to you in sealed envelopes for you to send to us with your completed application form and essays. Applying has two parts: first EMAIL YOUR INTENT TO APPLY NO LATER THAN APRIL 8 to STREAMYTI@gmail.com. Then complete the application and secure references - ALL MATERIALS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN MAY 1, 2016. Please note that it is *your* responsibility to make sure that all of your application materials arrive here on time, so you may want to give a friendly reminder to your recommenders as the deadline draws near.
